Organization: Growing Oshkosh and the re:TH!NK Farm to School Program in Winnebago County

When: Summer months, starting June through August

Where: Oshkosh elementary and middle school gardens

Job Title: School Garden Caretaker

Expectations and Responsibilities: Help out with a school garden at one of the Oshkosh schools. Tasks include, gardening (watering/picking weeds) and working with children in a school garden.

Time Requirements: Help volunteer for one hour or as many hours as you'd like! Indicate your availability when signing up to volunteer.

Skills and Qualifications: Ability to work with young children. Not required to have knowledge on gardening. Growing Oshkosh will provide you with all the information that you need!

Orientation and Training: No orientation or training is required.

Benefits: Students engage in hands on learning through gardening and gain basic knowledge about gardening and agriculture. During the harvest season you will also have the opportunity to take some of the fresh and healthy produce home with you to share with family and friends!
