Job Title: Local Food Ambassador

Expectations and Responsibilities: Help us in serving local food samples to elementary school students through school cafeteria-tastings, while encouraging students in becoming healthy adventurous eaters!

Time Requirements: Visit a designated elementary school during their school lunch hours. Times will range anywhere from 10:30a.m. to 12:45p.m. (times will vary for each school).

Skills and Qualifications: Ability to work with young children and inspire them in eating more fruits and vegetables.

Orientation and Training: No training is required.

Benefits: Help turn the tide in early healthy eating habits by inspiring children to eat more fruits and vegetables. The Farm to School program promotes the long term health of children by making changes to the school food environment that encourages children to eat more local, fresh fruits and vegetables. Local farmers benefit from this program by providing them with access to new markets through school sales. In addition, students are also educated on where their food comes from.
